From Vienna International Airport (VIE) to the Intercontinental Vienna

The location of **VIE** is relatively close to the city center of Vienna.

Under normal traffic conditions a local **Taxi** or **Uber** should take about 20-30 min from VIE to the **Intercontinental** located at Johannesgasse 28, 1030 Vienna.





If you want to use the excellent Viennese **Public Transport** system, you could prebook tickets for the **CAT** (**C**ity **A**irport **T**rain) Link: Non-stop airport transfer to Vienna! City Airport Train which has its station right at the airport taking you non-stop to "Wien Mitte" (Landstrasse). From there you can take the subway line "**U4**" from "Landstrasse" to "Stadtpark" which is only one station away in the direction of "Hütteldorf". Once you get off U4 at station "Stadtpark", the **Intercontinental** lies directly across the street (30 meters).

National Knights Days of the Exarchate of Finland in the City of Oulu May 26th -28th 2023

OCM – Exarchate of Finland 45 years

This year it was the turn of the Bailiwick of Northern Finland to organize the Knights´-Days in the city of Oulu. We had been there ten years earlier and we knew what to expect; well organized days with spirituality and emotions. It was the secretary of the Bailiwick, colonel (rtd) Heikki Hiltula who was the main organizer and the spirituality came with the Bailie, future Military Bishop of the Finnish Defence Forces Pekka Asikainen.

The Knights Days started on the Friday evening with a support concert for the Ukrainians in the Norhern Finland. The concert took place in the Oulu Cathedral and the performers

were the MPK Military Band of the Northern Finland, tenor Aki Alamikkotervo and Ynnin Pojat, a boys' choir. The warmhearted and emotional concert ended with the piece Highland Cathedral and a sack pipe. At the same time the flag of Ukraine reminded to us the reason of the concert; to help and to support the Ukrainians. Takings from the concert and a separate collection will be donated to the social work of the local orthodox parish.

The evening continued with a reception organized by the City of Oulu. In the House of the County Government we heard about the positive news of the City of Oulu and enjoyed a delicious service. Our host was the Chairman of the City Council NIMI? He is a OCM Knight.

Saturday started with the annual meeting of the OCM- Exarchate of Finland (OCM-Suomen Konstantinus Yhdistys ry) a registered association. No special decisions was expected and the meeting was chaired with routine by Bailie Pekka Asikainen. It was noticed that the Exarchate had formed a new task; prelate of ecumenism. The undertaker of this new task is OCM Knight, professor of theology Jukka Knuutila.

After the annual meeting it was time to handle an expected and important matter; the strategy of the Exarchate of Finland and it's Bailiwicks together with the action plan for the coming years. After two years of work in different working groups and seminars, the strategy was ready. Work had been done with a top-down and bottom-up principle. Meaning was to clarify what the OCM spirit and thoughts with actions are all about. And return

back to basics of the OCM Order, bring it to present and secure the future of the OCM. The Exarch Erkko Kajander represented the summary of the strategy. The mission, vision had been revised and the values checked and defined. We have four values: ecumenism, Christian Faith, responsibility for the fellow man and tolerance. The slogan of the Exarchate of Finland is: "For the fellow men – in this time".

For the coming years three action areas were formed; ecumenism, assistance work and tolerance. These areas have goals, action plans, responsibilities with resources and cooperation partners.

The dames and knights present at the meeting liked the strategy with action plans. This will clarify and guide the work of the Exarchate with it's Bailiwicks. The strategy was highly praised.

At lunch the Exarch Erkko Kajander read the greetings received from the Master of the OCM Order, Friedrich, Duke and Prince von Beaufort-Spontin. The greetings were addressed to the Dames and Knights of the Exarchate of Finland. In his greetings the Master noted the 45 years of the Exarchate. His thoughts went however further back to the year 1960 when the first Constantinian Association was formed in Finland. His greetings brought up the meaning of the highly respected Yrjö von Grönhagen to the OCM in Finland and to the whole Order. The Master drew attention to the fact that Christian attitude and Constantinian spirit of the OCM and the obligation to give assistance to the fellow men has made OCM attractive to many Finns.

The Master told further that he knew that the Exarchate of Finland has all possibilities and power to keep the Constantinian virtues live and, in that way full fill the obligations of charity in the Patriarchate of Alexandria as in our own country.

To finish his greetings the Master wished all a festive Day of Knights and a hopeful future. The afternoon of Saturday was reserved to the Knights Forum. The topic was: OCM and tolerance today. The forum included three outlines and a panel discussion with questions and answers. The forum was lead by Bailie Pekka Asikainen. Tolerance is one of the action plans of the Exarchate of Finland. It will get attention in our work. And as we remember tolerance is one of the ideals of the OCM order. Perhaps we can come back to this topic in another article in the Constantinian News.

'The high point of the Day of Knights is the Ceremony of Knighst' and Dames' dubbing. The place was the Oulu Cathedral which gave a perfect spiritual and emotional setting to the ceremony. This was the second ceremony after the pandemic. It was turn to promotions, rewards and ceremonial dubbing of new dames and knights.

In the beginning of the ceremony the Bailie of the Bailiwick of Northern Finland, pastor Pekka Asikainen held a divine speech. Pekka is a Doctor of Theology and Philosophy and a short time ago he was chosen to be the Military Bishop of the Finnish Defence Forces. We are glad and proud of his new nomination to this important high office.

The gala dinner was held in the cabinet of the Lapland Hotels Oulu. The atmosphere was warmhearted and knightly. The Exarch brought up in his speech part of the history of the OCM Order, its meaning today and in the future, The new Dames and Knights got information about our Order, about our activities and about our obligations. This information is always useful to the older members as well.

The OCM ideas and principles came to Finland in 1959 and the first Bailiwick, Bailiwick of Helsinki, was formed in 1960. The Exarchate of Finland was formed in 1978 when the Bailiwick of Turku was formed. Today, there are 10 Bailiwicks in Finland and altogether 215 members. Included are 12 Dames. In Finland there are 18 Members of Honour of our Order.

The speech of the New Knight was held by Major Kari Brorstöm. He expressed well the meaning of the OCM values and goals in his speech and added that he wants to the part of these actions for good things. Kuva Kimmon kuvista.

Sunday morning started with slight rain. In Finland we have a tradition to lay a wreath at the soldier's grave before the divine service. In Oulu the wreath was laid at the statue of the fallen soldiers in the War of Liberation. Despite the slight rain the small ceremony was held with the spirit of three words: we thank, we honour, we remember.

The Knights' Days in the City of Oulu ended with a divine service and "church coffee" in the Cathedral of Oulu.


